

Lanhydrock Parish Council: Minutes of Meeting held in Lanhydrock War Memorial Hall at 19:30 on Monday 29th July 2024

1) NOTIFICATION THAT MEETINGS MAY BE ELECTONICALLY RECORDED

2) TO NOTE THOSE PRESENT AND TO RECEIVE ANY APOLOGIES:

- a) In attendance: Cllr. J. Coad (chairman), Cllr. M. Coad, Cllr. P. Miller, Cllr. A. Coad, Cllr. SA Hayward, S. Knight (clerk) and one member of the public.
- b) Apologies: Cllr. J Cruse (C.C).

3) TO RECEIVE ANY DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST FROM MEMBERS:

4) PUBLIC FORUM:

- a) **Gridlock at Respryn** occurs whenever the A38 Glynn Valley is closed because the bridge can't cope with the additional volume of traffic seeking an unofficial diversion.

ACTION: Clerk to write to Highways to ask their thoughts on a solution, noting that signage is unlikely to be effective and a more physical barrier (e.g. electric bollards) may work better.

- b) **The brown advance directional sign outside The Old Vicarage** continues to cause disruption for the nearby resident, who repeated his desire for it to be removed.

5) TO RESOLVE THAT THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING ARE AN ACCURATE RECORD:

- a) It was resolved that the Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 27.05.2024 were an accurate record.
- b) It was resolved that the Minutes of the Extraordinary meeting held on 02.07.2024 were an accurate record.

6) TO RECEIVE ORAL OR WRITTEN REPORTS AND AUTHORISE ANY ACTION:

- a) **Cornwall Council:** Cllr. Cruse submitted a report in advance of the meeting that noted:
 - i) **Speeding at Kirland** is to be monitored via RadarClass signage, to be installed on Kirland Road, near the golf course.
 - ii) **Respryn Clearway** is continuing to be monitored for parking compliance. Cllr. Cruse has advised the traffic wardens on the peak times to visit.

iii) **Regional Devolution** is currently under discussion in Cornwall Council. Pressure is being applied to councillors to begin discussions with Devon (and possibly further afield) to move towards regional devolution with a regional mayor. Cllr. Cruse does not support the idea but Cornwall Council is preparing a white paper for the government on the subject.

- a) **Any planning applications received after publication of agenda:** None received.
- b) **Neighbourhood Plan:** It was noted that the parish doesn't have a Neighbourhood Plan because of a previous lack of interest within the parish in creating one and a lack of resource to do so. A resident attending the meeting suggested that Cllr. Cruse might be a source of financial support if the parish stance changes.

- a) **Community News:** The chairman noted that the War Memorial Hall interior refurbishment works were continuing to make good progress.
- b) **Wildanet:** It was noted that Wildnet are currently working within the parish and had closed Percy's Lane on the day of the meeting for this purpose.
